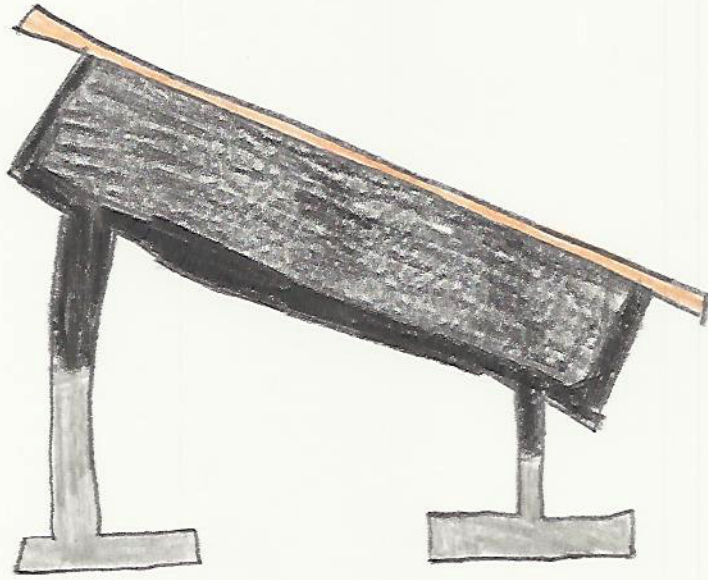

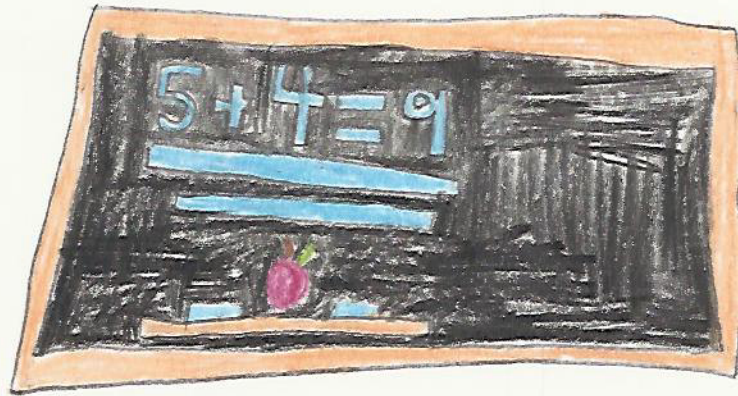

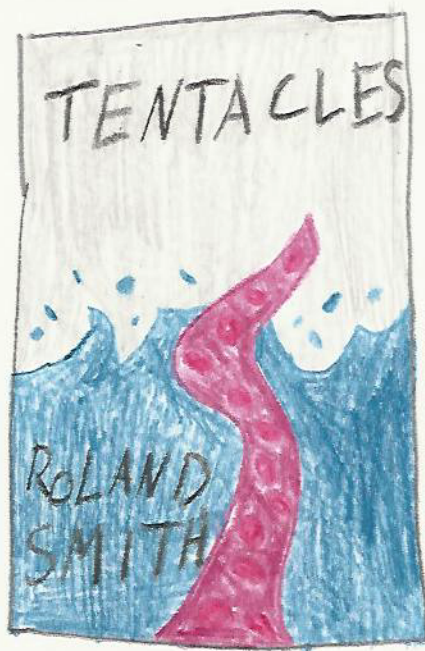
Funny Stuff

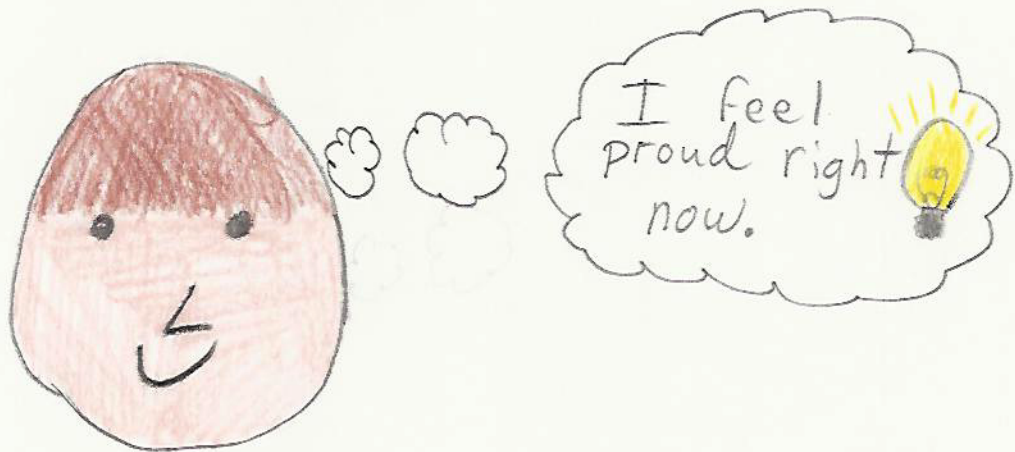
The Best Book

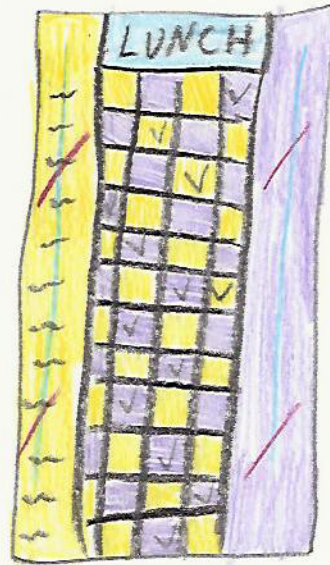
Good Friends

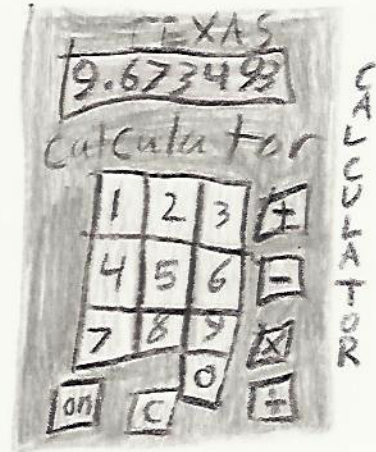

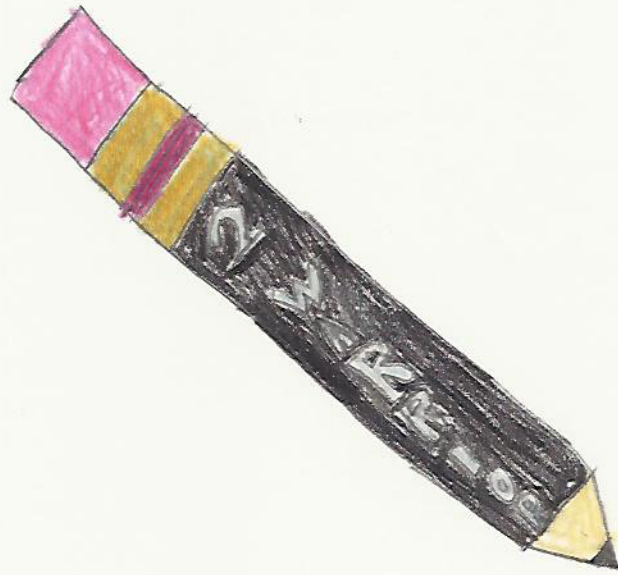
The Best Subject

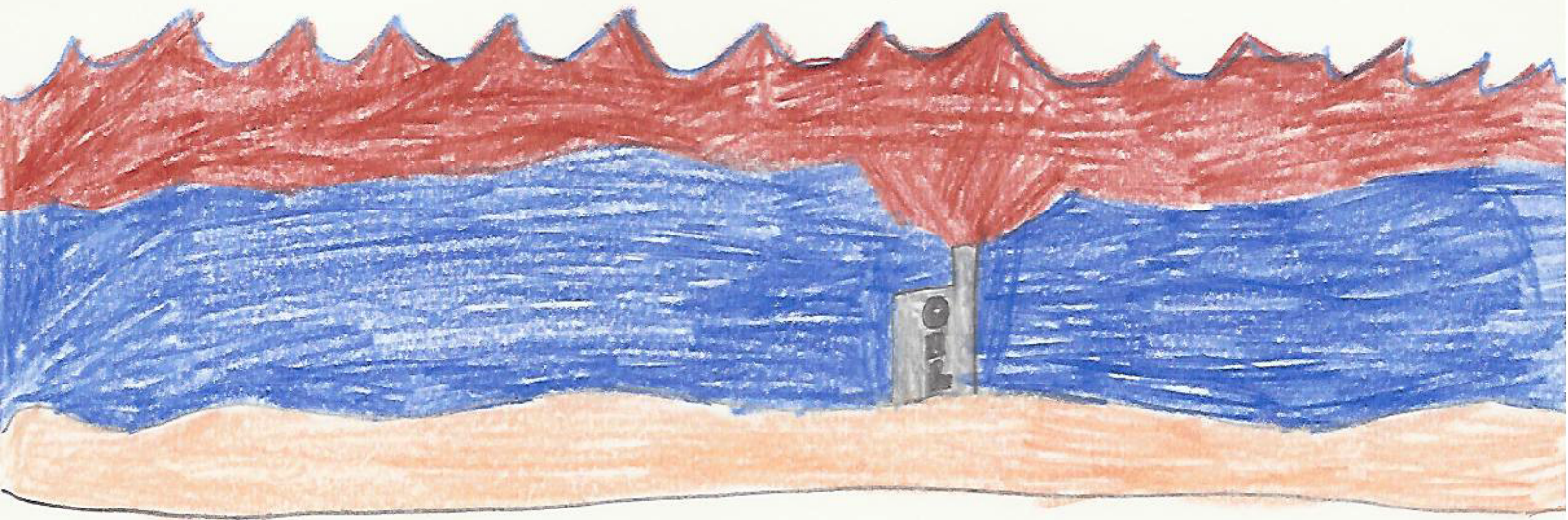
My Favorite Project
